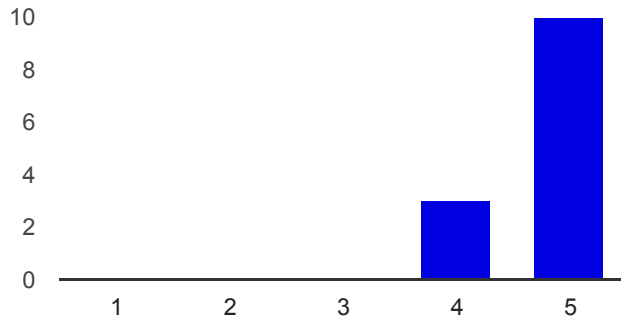

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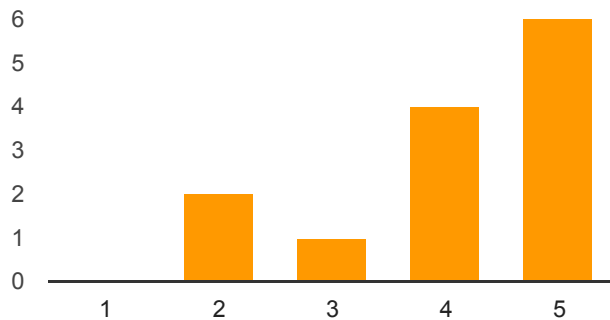

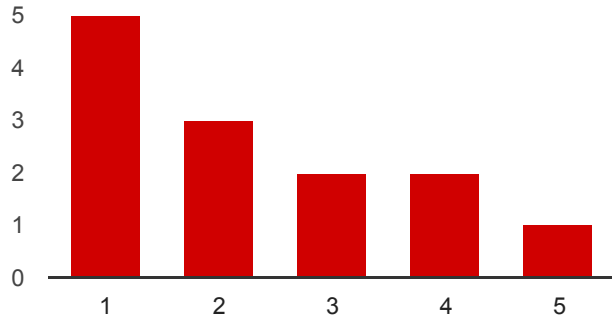

As for the structure of the class, this has been my favorite in 3 years in App.

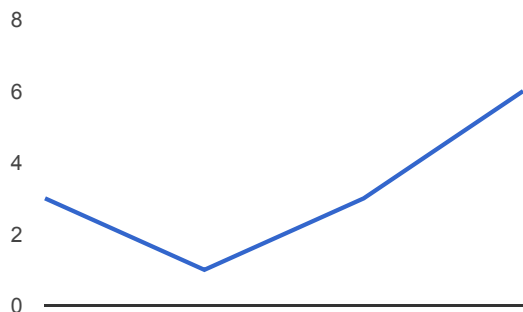
